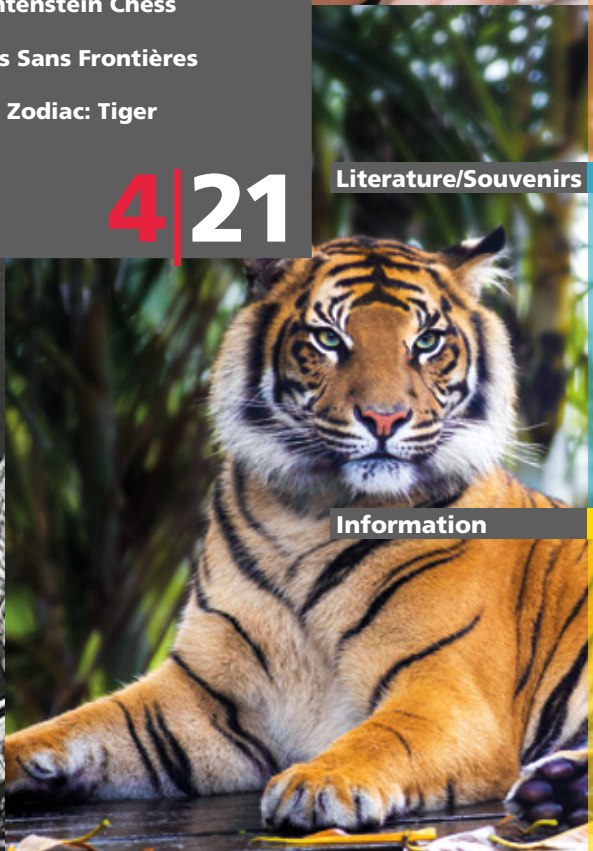

Official stamp issue of the Principality of Liechtenstein

Liechtenstein's Chess Federation is celebrating its 50th anniversary on 1 December 2021. It is home to the two chess clubs Vaduz and Triesen and has been a member of the Liechtenstein Olympic Committee (LOC) since June 2011. One year before its big anniversary, the federation decided to change its name and since then has been known as the Liechtenstein Chess Federation (LCF). At the same time, the federation's logo, which focuses on the figure of the knight, was modernised.

The "Knight" (face value: CHF 0.85) also serves as the motif for one of the two special stamps now

being issued to mark the federation's 50th anniversary. The second stamp shows the "King" (face value: CHF 1.80). The chess stamps, issued for the first time in Philately Liechtenstein's history, are in white, black and gold, embellished with gold foil embossing and the high relief embossing of the individual figures. Among other things, the Chess Federation has dedicated itself to youth development. With its project "Chess in Schools", it contributes to the personality development of children as well as to supporting their promotion and education. But many adults and especially senior citizens of all genders are also passionate chess players.

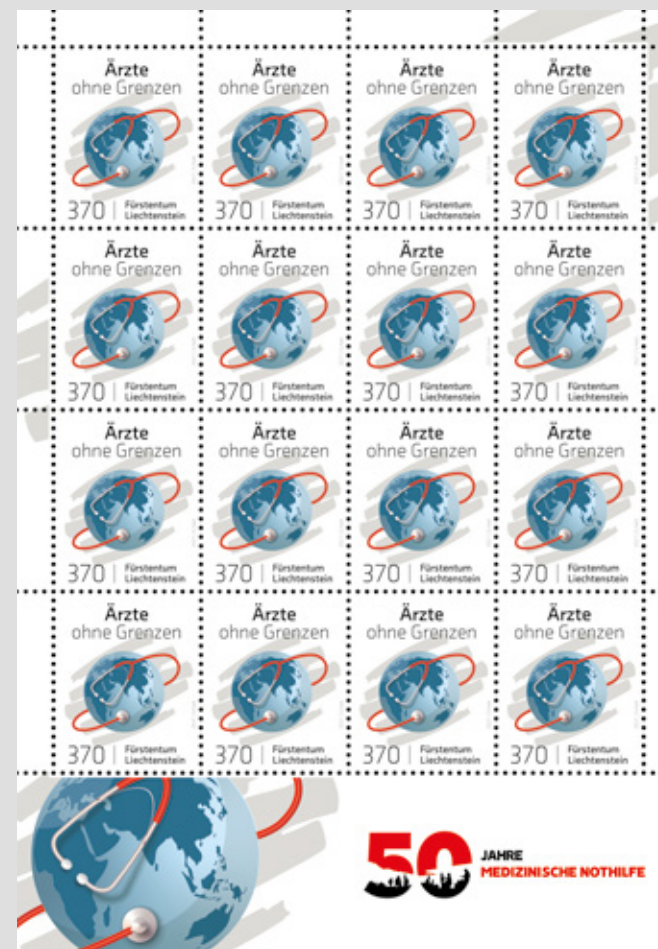

Médecins Sans Frontières (MSF), sometimes rendered in English as Doctors Without Borders, is a private aid organisation with an international focus. It was founded in Paris in 1971 and consists mostly of doctors and nurses, but also of people from numerous other professions such as logisticians, administrators and financial and human resource specialists. The staff provide medical aid in more than 70 countries around the world – wherever human lives are threatened. The main reasons for their missions are armed conflicts, but also epidemics, pandemics and natural disasters or exclusion from the health system. The organisation is 97 per cent financed by private donations.

According to its charter, MSF helps people in need regardless of their ethnic origin or their religious, philosophical or political convictions. In recognition of its pioneering humanitarian work on several continents, the initiative was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize in 1999.

Philately Liechtenstein is honouring MSF on the occasion of its 50th anniversary with the special stamp "Worldwide Without Borders" (face value: CHF 3.70).

The traditional and popular Christmas stamps are presented in oriental style this year, which is reflected in the choice of colours and detailing in gold. The four self-adhesive square special stamps are available in sheets of 20 or individually.

With her choice of motifs, designer Sereina Hatt establishes a connection to the Christmas story of Christianity. On the stamp "The Guiding Star" (face value: CHF 0.85), the star that pointed the way to Bethlehem for the Three Wise Men takes centre stage. "The Shepherd" (face value: CHF 1.00), symbolically represented by a sheep, refers to the shepherds who, after an angel proclaimed the birth of Jesus, also set out to see the Son of God lying in a manger.

The "Holy Spirit" (face value: CHF 1.50), who had come upon Mary as the Spirit of God and made her conceive her son nine months earlier, appears in the form of a dove like in the Bible. A candle flanked by a plant represents "The Gifts" (face value: CHF 2.00), which the Wise Men from the East offered to the Saviour.

The sheer diversity of Chinese culture is fascinating, one part of which is astrology with its twelve signs of the zodiac. In the Chinese calendar, the coming new year begins on 1 February 2022. It will be under the sign of the tiger and last until 21 January 2023. The Chinese horoscope characterises the tiger as courageous, strong and full of energy. People born under its sign are agile, energetic, self-confident and assertive. Astrologers say that the element water, which is predominant in 2022, makes the impulsive tiger more peaceful. It therefore has less of a tendency to make rash decisions compared to its fellow species. The series on Chinese zodiac signs, which has meanwhile become a tradition, is slowly drawing to a close with the penultimate motif "Year of the Tiger" (face value: CHF 2.00). A characteristic feature of the self-adhesive special stamp is the fact that it is produced in the form of a filigree silhouette using the latest laser technology. The sheet of 4 stamps in the colour red, which is a symbol of good luck in China, is also punched out in the shape of a tiger. All imprints are embossed in classy looking gold foil.

"The supreme function of government is to promote the overall welfare of the people."

The Constitution is the basic law of our State. It makes transparent how the State defines itself as well as what all participants must contribute and may expect from each other. Since 5 October 1921, Liechtenstein has had a new foundation, and since that day, the aforementioned Article 14 has defined, without any changes, the supreme function of government. This exceptional stamp under the label "dieMarke.li" pays tribute to the 100th anniversary of the Constitution and highlights this central statement. The stamp was issued by the government of the Principality of Liechtenstein on Plexiglas, which is symbolic of the transparency mentioned.

First increase in prices for letters in 18 years

Liechtensteinische Post AG will be increasing the price of domestic A Mail letters by 10 centimes as of January 2022 and domestic B Mail letters will become 5 centimes more expensive. This is the first time that prices for letters have increased in 18 years.

Due to the close cooperation in the area of postal traffic between Liechtenstein and Switzerland, as

well as the almost identical range of products and services, it was also necessary to increase prices in Liechtenstein. The Liechtenstein government approved Liechtensteinische Post AG's application for the price increase after Swiss Post officially announced it was increasing its prices in Switzerland on 23 August 2021.

All deliveries are postage-paid. For orders below the minimum purchase of CHF 20.00 we apply a handling charge of max. CHF 7.00.

For subscriptions there is no minimum purchase. Our current new issues are delivered direct to subscribers' homes promptly, postage-paid and without handling charges. For customers having a standing order no handling charge will be applied for orders below the

minimum purchase. Subscriptions can be changed or terminated at any time.
